

Certification Mark Policy

1. Purpose

This Policy establishes the rules and requirements for use of all GCCLAB Trademarks and Certification Marks.

2. GCCLAB Certification Mark Ownership

The following organizational trademark is owned and controlled by GCCLAB.

3. ABBREVIATIONS & DEFINITIONS:

- Certified person(s)" or "Certified personnel(s)" refers also to "Certificate holder(s)"
- "Certification scheme" refers also to "Certificate program"
- "Certification marks" refers also to "Certificate marks"

3. Authorized Use of GCCLAB Certification Mark

GCCLAB grants permission to use the GCCLAB Certification Marks to GCCLAB certified personnel that have satisfied all applicable GCCLAB credentialing and certification requirements. Each GCCLAB certified personnel is authorized to use only the Certification Mark which represents the appropriate certification and credential.

- Each GCCLAB certified personnel may use the appropriate GCCLAB Certification Mark in personnel and business materials such as business cards and email signatures.
- Non-Assignability and Non-Transferability
- Permission to use the Certification Mark is limited to the certified person, and shall not be transferred to, assigned to, or otherwise used by any other individual, organization, or entity.

4. GCCLAB Certification Mark Use Policy Violation Reporting

Following receipt of information that an inappropriate or unauthorized use of the Certification Mark may have occurred; GCCLAB will determine if responsive action(s) will be taken, including the following:

- The alleged inappropriate or unauthorized Mark use will be reviewed.
- If a Policy violation may have occurred, GCCLAB shall communicate to the individual(s) and/or organization(s) involved, requesting that they cease the unauthorized use.
- If the Policy violation is not corrected, appropriate legal actions or sanctions shall be taken, including certification suspension or revocation doing their job.
